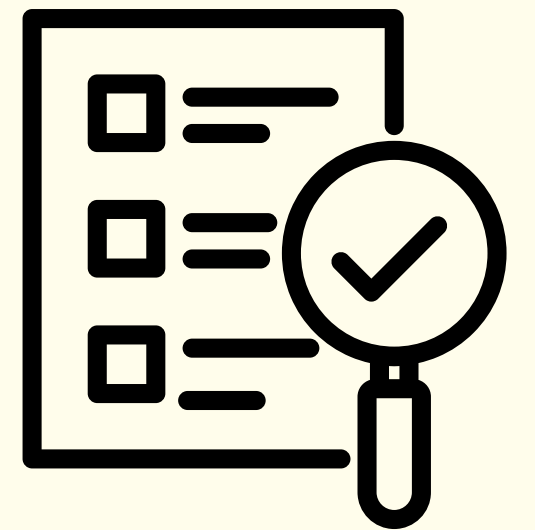
## RESEARCH QUESTION

2. What benefits can the legal stuff be derived from the use of NLP-based text summation in the field of providing easy comprehensible legal information to the nonexperts?

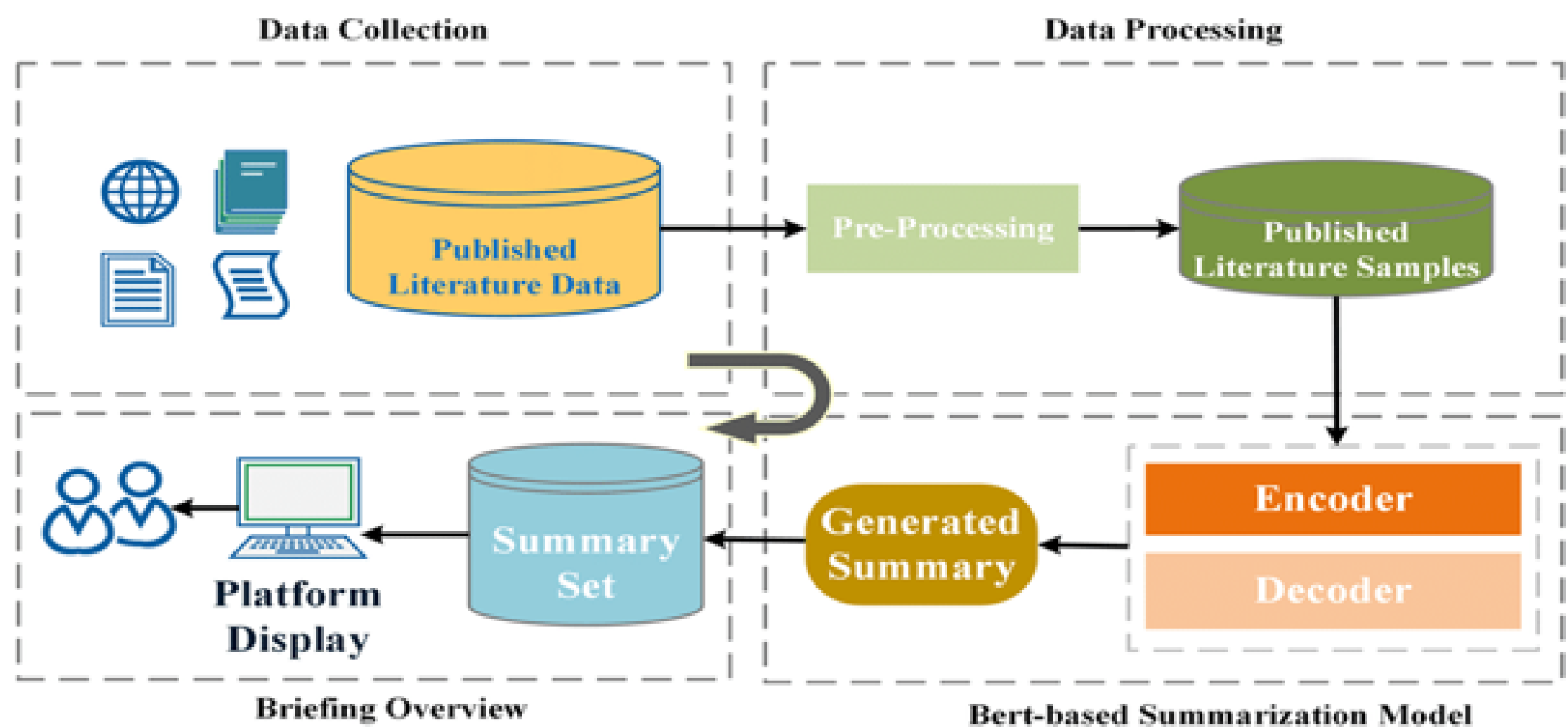


## LITERATURE REVIEW

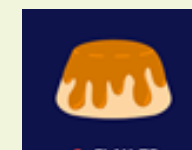
